Challenge identified No 2:

Objective and transparent grade conversion at Home university



Grade conversion



To ensure transparent and coherent information on the performance of the individual student, each HEI should provide – in addition to their national/institutional grading scale and an explanation of the scale – a statistical distribution table of the passing grades awarded in the programme or field of study attended by the student (grade distribution table) showing how the grading scale is actually used in that programme.

Grade conversion



The grade distribution table was first introduced in the ECTS Users' Guide in 2009, as a replacement for the previous ECTS grading scales (A, B, C, D, E), which are not used anymore.

Grade distribution tables have to be developed in a *standardised* format for reference groups of students enrolled in degree programmes belonging to the same field of studies.









EGRACONS tool



The EGRACONS Grade Conversion Tool offers a user-friendly webbased tool for grade conversion that ensures a fair and transparent grade conversion of grades obtained abroad based on the guidelines of the new ECTS Guide. It is available to all European HEIs enabling a transparent interpretation of students' accomplishments. The tool enables both single conversion (a single student grade to a single grade) and multiple conversion (all the grades of one student on a Transcript of Records).
