TRNAVA UNIVERSITY IN TRNAVA, Slovakia

The town **Trnava** is one of the oldest and most beautiful medieval towns in Slovakia. It is situated in a plain under the Little Carpathians on the main commercial roads of Europe, near to other medieval towns in Central Europe – 50 km from capitol Bratislava and 130 km from Vienna.

Historical **Trnava University** represents one of the oldest universities

in Slovakia. Trnava University was established by Cardinal Peter Pázmaň

in 1635. The university became well-known also thanks to an observatory founded by Maximilián Hell, a university library, gardens and a theatre.

It existed for 142 years and in 1777, it was moved to Buda in Hungary (Slovakia was at that times the part of Habsburg Monarchy). The National Council of the Slovak Republic reestablished Trnava University on March 1992 and reopened the university on July 1992.


