2.3.2. Decision Response

Students will be informed about acceptance once their application is completed, decision takes approximately 4 weeks.

2.3.3. Transcripts of Records

Each student can generate and print the Transcript of Records with official electronic signatures via LFU:online. A signed and stamped version is issued by the International Relations Office on demand.

2.3.4. Termination of Agreement

This agreement can be terminated at any time by mutual consent. In the event of unilateral termination, a notice of at least one academic year should be given. This means that a unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by 1 September of one given year will only take effect as of 1 September of the next year. Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of conflict.
