<b>Language of Instruction</b>	The languages of instruction at the University of

<b>Recommended German Competency</b>	Salzburg are German and (partially) English. It is recommended that every incoming exchange student has sufficient proficiency in the German (B1/B2) language but <b>no formal language proficiency</b> is required.
<b>German Language Courses</b>	<p>The Department of German at the University of Salzburg offers intensive German language courses (6 hours/week) on different levels during the whole academic year. Course fee: € 120/semester. Every student has to pass a placement test at the beginning of the semester.</p> <p>In addition, the University Language Centre also offers German language classes (2-4 hours/ week). Course fee: € 45-65/semester.</p> <p>PREPARATORY German Language Courses We offer a two-week <i>preparatory language course</i> for exchange students (mid September / mid February) at a reduced participation fee. <b>Course Catalogue and Searching for Courses using PLUS<sup>online</sup></b>	PLUS <sup>online</sup> is accessible from the University's website. In order to access information students do not have to be registered. Students are able to look for courses online from all over the world. Enrolment in classes is possible only after personal registration in Salzburg. Should appropriate classes for the field of study for the scheduled period not be available on the system, students can choose classes from the current academic year / semester.
<b>Work Load</b>	We do not request any credits or units that undergraduate students need to complete. The University of Salzburg does not set minimum or maximum of work load.
<b>Accommodation</b>	The University of Salzburg does not own any student dormitories and therefore cannot offer a housing service. ## Visa Requirements

<b>Are Exchange Students required to obtain a Student Visa?</b>	EU-, EEA- and CH-Citizens who fulfil the requirements of sufficient financial funds and proof of health insurance valid in Austria do not need a visa. "Third country nationals" are required to have an entry or residence permit. The type of permit is dependent on the length and purpose of the stay. For stays up to three months (Japan: up to six months), entry and residence visas are not required from citizens of selected countries*. If a stay is planned longer than the mentioned period a visa or residence permit is required. *Detailed information on entry and residence regulations is available at the Austrian representative authority (Embassy / Consulate) in the home country or via the website of the Austrian Exchange Service: <a href="https://oead.at/en/to-austria/entry-residence-and-employment/">https://oead.at/en/to-austria/entry-residence-and-employment/</a>

## Insurances

<b>Health Insurance</b>	Every exchange students must prove that she/he has health insurance that is valid in Austria. Cost: approx. € 58,39 per month (2018), if necessary.
<b>Other Insurances</b>	Every exchange student is member of the Austrian Student Union automatically by being registered at the University of Salzburg. This membership includes a liability and accident insurance.
