APPLICATION DOCUMENTS

Documents to be uploaded into Mobility Online (only PDF files):

- Copy of a valid passport or identity card (both sides)
- Transcript of records of all previous years in higher education
- University Regulations and Data Protection statement duly signed
- Learning agreement duly signed by the student and the academic coordinator of the sending university.



ACADEMIC AND ENROLMENT REQUIREMENTS

French is the main language of instruction. We recommend a B2 level.
