Nomination Requirements

Formal nomination of students must be received from the partner institution before the above-noted deadline, including the applicants':

- ***name***
- ***date of birth***
- ***email-address***
- ***level of studies and area of specialization.***

Application Requirements

Applicants must fill in an **Application Form**, found here: <https://filmovka.cz/ifs/admission/> and email it through to ifs@filmovka.cz, complete with:

- A passport / identification card scan
- motivational letter
- CV
- transcript of records (from home university, for the last accessible academic year)
- completed Online Learning Agreement

It is not necessary to provide any proof of proficiency in the English language, however, we may request a ZOOM call to determine if the level of English is of the required level.

Accommodation

The Film Academy of Miroslav Ondříček **does not** have its own dormitories. However, at the applicant's request, the school will assist in finding the most appropriate solution as per the applicant's requests and budget. Possibilities include local dorms, shared apartments, private accommodation, long-term hotel residence, etc.

In the event that an applicant requests assistance in securing accommodation **a 1200 CZK administrative fee will be charged to the applicant upon arrival.**

Visa Requirements

All students accepted into studies at FAMO will receive a formal letter of acceptance, which will be required for a study visa application if necessary (for non-EU students). As visa application durations appear to be extending, we recommend earlier application to allow for their timely processing.
