What you need to know before choosing a courses?

- To prevent course overlap in your timetable, do not mix courses from FCT faculty with courses from FET and FFBT

FCT + FCE ✓
FET + FFBT + FCE ✓
FCT + FET + FFBT ✗

- Students should choose only within the respective level - **undergraduate** (Bachelor) or **graduate** (Master).
Undergraduate (*Bachelor's*) courses - the code of the course starts with **AB**
Graduate (*Master's*) courses- the code of the course starts with **AM**
- If you *combine courses from undergraduate and graduate levels*, you will most likely have to deal with **timetable overlaps** and **change your Learning Agreement**.
- The number of courses registered per semester must be for the minimum **of 20 ECTS**; recommended **30 ECTS** (ECTS grading system - https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/ECTS_grading_scale)
