Restrictions	Non-Erasmus students cannot be admitted to medicine, dentistry and pharmacy. Admission to certain lectures in law, psychology and to practical sports lectures is restricted.
Academic advice	Exchange students will receive the contact data of the responsible departmental coordinator who will advise them in academic matters. Lectures from past and current courses can be found in our lecture directory .
Grading system	We offer an overview of the grading system used at FAU.
Language of instruction	The main language of instruction at FAU is German, but each department offers lectures in English. The faculties provide lists of English courses on their websites.
Language courses	A preparatory German course will be held before the start of lectures. The course fee and its credits can be found online . FAU language centre offers free language courses at all levels.
Transcript of Records	Exchange students can download their transcript of records via one of FAU's online platforms. They will receive further information during their stay. A signed and stamped version will only be issued upon request.

Health insurance	German health insurance is obligatory. Accident insurance and liability insurance is highly recommended. All insurances should cover the whole stay in Germany. Exempted from the obligatory German insurance are all students with European health insurance and EHIC. Travel health insurance: non-EU citizens should have travel health insurance at least valid until the start of lectures. Please be aware that international travel insurances are not sufficient and will not be approved by FAU and German authorities.
