1. Deadline for nominations

For winter semester (October-March): May 31

For summer semester (April-July/August): November 30

Earlier nominations are always welcome

Please send nomination to erasmus@unr.uni-freiburg.de and include the following information:

- Surname, Name
- Date of birth
- Field of study at the home university
- Study cycle at home university (BA, MA, PhD; students in year 4 or 5 of a Bachelor programme are allowed to participate in Master courses)
- Current semester of studies at home university
- Email address of the student

2. Application deadlines for students

For winter semester: June 15
For summer semester: January 15

As soon as we receive a nomination our central Erasmus office sends the link for the online application procedure directly to the student.

3. Lecture periods

Winter Semester: 19.10.2020 - 12.2.2021(Bachelor)

19.10.2020 - 05.03.2021 (Master)

Summer Semester: 19.04.2021 - 24.07.2021(to be confirmed)

4. Courses

Please remember that Bachelor students can choose only courses from our Bachelor programmes and have no access to the courses of our Master programmes. Exception: If students are enrolled in a 4/5-year



Bachelor/undergraduate programme and do their Erasmus exchange in their 4th year, they are allowed to take Master courses.

At the time when students have to fill in their learning agreement the course catalogues for the semester of their stay abroad is not yet published. To fill in the learning agreement we therefore recommend using the course catalogues from the year before and making a provisional choice. The catalogues for the coming fall semester will be published only in August of the respective year.

A few weeks before the semester starts we will send the updated course catalogue to all incoming students and ask them to check and confirm their selection. We will then try to book the places. However, it might happen that a course is already full booked with regular students. In this case we will offer alternatives. The learning agreement can be changed within 4 weeks after arrival in Freiburg.

5. Language requirements

All our Bachelor courses are taught in German. To be accepted students need a German level of B2.

In our **Master** programmes, we have modules taught in German and English. Depending on the choice of modules Erasmus students have to submit a language proof in German or/and English with minimum **B2 level**. Our regular Master students have to prove a C1 level.

We recommend to be strict with language proofs. Our master courses are organised as a sequence of 3 weeks blocks with exams at the end of each block. This implies that students cannot develop their language skills throughout the semester, but have to be able to understand and to communicate right from the beginning.

6. Housing

After registration students can apply online for <u>housing</u> in a student residence. If Eramus students apply right away it is very likely that they get a place.
