## OUTGOING Students

Selection and nomination	At the University of Münster, the departments carry out the selection of the students independently. The departmental coordinators nominate their selected outgoing students to the partner universities and are the contact persons in all scientific matters.

## INCOMING Students

Nomination	The students need to be nominated by their home university. Later on, they will be informed about the <b>online application procedure</b> . Nomination deadlines are: For winter semester: <b>May 1<sup>st</sup></b> For summer semester: <b>November 1<sup>st</sup></b> Please include name, birth date, e-mail address, subject and term and send the nomination to <a href="mailto:admin.ess@wwu.de">admin.ess@wwu.de</a> .	
Application deadline	Students must hand in the application for admission to the <b>Exchange Student Service</b> : For winter semester: <b>June 1<sup>st</sup></b> For summer semester: <b>December 1<sup>st</sup></b> .	
Language of instruction	Most courses are taught in German, only very few lectures and seminars are taught in English or other languages. <b>There are no additional courses for exchange students</b> . Please make sure that your students acquire some German skills before they arrive to Münster or they concentrate on language courses at our university.	
Academic calendar	The academic year is divided in two semesters: - the winter semester starts in October, exams take place in February - the summer semester starts in April, exams take place in July and August. Lecture period changes from year to year. Social Contribution (mandatory)	<p>Each student has to pay the semester contribution fee of around 270€ per semester. The fee includes a public transport ticket for busses and regional trains within Münster and North Rhine-Westphalia.</p>
Student housing	<p>The University of Münster is not a campus university and does not offer accommodation to students.</p> <p><b>The housing situation in Münster is very tense and students should search for housing right after their nomination.</b></p> <p>Exchange students can apply for a room with the student services – <b>Studierendenwerk</b>, a provider that offers rooms for students only.
