APPLICATION PROCEDURE INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS (Baden-Württemberg-Scholarship, Partner-cooperations)	<p>After their nomination, students need to send their application documents digitally to international@abk-stuttgart.de.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Application Form2. Passport sized picture3. Motivation letter (incl. description of project or field of interest, in German or English)4. CV5. Portfolio (A4, no originals)6. Transcript <p>Application Deadline: Winter term/whole year: by 15th April Summer term: by 15th October</p>
LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS	<p>Courses are held in German; however, most German students and academic staff are fluent in English. A sound level of German (at least A2-B2) is of great advantage but not mandatory. English language skills should be excellent (at least B2-C2).</p>

INSURANCE

Students from other European Union (EU) countries who are already insured in their country of origin do not have to insure themselves in Germany. With the European Health Insurance Card (EHIC) they can directly go to a doctor and use their insurance card there.

Students from all other countries must get insurance in Germany, even if they already have a health insurance in their home country. Travel insurance will not be accepted.
