Accommodation	One room apartment with shared kitchen and bathroom costs: between € 180 and € 220 per month. Deposit of € 380 has to be paid immediately after the arrival.
Food	Approximately € 1.40 - € 2.20 per meal at the student cafeteria (Mensa)
Students' Union Fee	The student will have to pay a contribution to the students' association which is € 144.00 for one semester (for students studying in Zwickau). It includes a city transportation ticket. For students studying in Reichenbach or Schneeberg it is € 78.40.
