Requirements	<p>Bachelor Degrees: It is essential for mobility condition to have passed at least 120 ECTS credits (you can count credits which you are still studying now and you are going to pass just before coming to our School). We set this requirement, because we do not offer courses of the 1st and 2nd year of bachelor for mobility students.</p> <p>Master Degrees: To enroll master courses we will request you to have completed 150 ECTS before the beginning of classes, and the offer will increase if your credits completed are successively 180, 210, 240, etc. You must count your credits completed including both bachelor and master years (you can count credits which you are still studying now and you are going to pass just before coming to our School).</p>

Insurance before coming	<p>· EU students. Students from the European Union (or Norway or Switzerland) need to have both the European Health Insurance Card (EHIC) and an additional private insurance that covers for your stay and that includes, as well as <u>health assistance</u> (including diagnostic tests and surgical interventions), <u>accidents</u>, (compensation for permanent disability and death compensation), <u>repatriation</u> and <u>civil liability</u>. Health assistance is covered by the EHIC, but the rest aren't. If you do not already have the additional insurance, the UPC has an agreement with OnCampus estudia and offers a very complete one for the entire stay at a very affordable price. You must choose the Oncampus estudia (which is for students).</p> <p>· Non EU-students need to have the private insurance that includes health assistance, accident, repatriation, civil responsibility.
