Requirements	<p><b>Bachelor Degrees:</b> It is essential for mobility condition to have passed at least 120 ECTS credits (you can count credits which you are still studying now and you are going to pass just before coming to our School). We set this requirement, because we do not offer courses of the 1st and 2nd year of bachelor for mobility students.</p> <p><b>Master Degrees:</b> To enroll master courses we will request you to have completed 150 ECTS before the beginning of classes, and the offer will increase if your credits completed are successively 180, 210, 240, etc. You must count your credits completed including both bachelor and master years (you can count credits which you are still studying now and you are going to pass just before coming to our School).</p>

Healthcare can be covered by the European Health Insurance Card, but the other items are to be covered by an additional insurance.
