Incoming students can choose courses within their field-program, within the limits established by both the sending and receiving university.



#### **Grading system**

Students at Universidad Isabel I have two grading options during the ordinary examination session. It is essential that students choose one of the options before the due deadline.

Grading System	
Continuous assessment 60% - 40%	<ul><li>60% of the final grade is made up with the exercises and homework assigned during the course.</li><li>40% is the final exam which must be taken face-to-face.</li></ul>
Competency Evaluation Task 50% - 50%	50% of the final grade is made up by a multi-part assignment due at the end of the course. 50% is the final exam which must be taken face-to-face.
