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NOMINATION PROCESS

1. **Establishment of an interinstitutional agreement** between the institutions.
2. **Nomination by home institution including:** student's name, contact information, field of study, the desired TAI Bachelor's Degree and desired mobility period.

Please remember that being nominated by the home institution doesn't imply the acceptance of the student.

3. After being nominated, TAI will send an email to the students with the **instructions for the application process**.

The following documents will be asked:

1. **Application form.**
2. **CV.**
3. **A transcript of records.**
4. **A portfolio (pdf format)**
5. **A motivation letter.**
6. **ID/passport copy (Spanish Language Certificate if applicable).**

APPLICATION PROCESS

The portfolio must include related materials to the student's projects and their creation processes, specifying their role, and including a brief critical analysis of each of them. If it contains multimedia files, they might have open access or contain the links to YouTube. **The students interested in Performing Arts and Screen Acting degree must present a videobook instead of a portfolio.**

*Students can find the catalogue of courses on our website, however **there might be changes depending on the places available.***

Students from non-EU Countries will also be required to have a copy of the **Visa** and **Health Insurance** before their arrival to TAI.

INSTRUCTION LANGUAGE

SPANISH

The required language level is B2 of CEFR* to follow the Spanish classes.

ENGLISH

TAI has three Bachelors in **English** with limited availability of places. For those ones, **the required level language is B2.**

A language certificate is required to prove language level. The International Department holds the right to interview the student during the selection process to prove the Spanish/English language skills.

DISCLAIMERS AND SPECIFICATIONS:

- Due to capacity limitations, the number of places for incoming students will be limited in most degrees, and therefore, some of the nominated students may be rejected.
- Exchanges in the **Performing Arts and Screen Acting** degree are only possible for the 1st semester or the whole academic year. **Incoming students for the 2nd semester cannot** join those subjects due to the difficulties of incorporation in new students to final projects.
- Exchanges in the **Filmmaking** degree are only possible in the 1st semester or whole academic year. **Incoming students for the 2nd semester cannot** join those subjects due to the difficulties of incorporation in final projects.
- Exchange students in the **Filmmaking** degree **cannot join Directing, Camera and Sound specialties**.
- Filmmaking degree students cannot enroll in “Proyectos I, II, III”.

ACCOMODATION

There is a wide range of accommodation in Madrid: shared flats, apartments, dormitories... We will give the student a Guide with the different options to facilitate his/her search process.

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MENTORING PROGRAM AND WELCOME WEEK

Before their arrival, exchange students will be approached by assigned TAI mentors, who will help them before and throughout their stay if they need assistance regarding the functioning of the school, classes, or life in Madrid.

VISA AND REGISTRY INFORMATION (only for Non-European students)

Students coming from a country outside the European Union might need to apply for a Visa before coming to Spain. The student will have to present an Acceptance Letter issued by TAI in the Spanish Embassy in his/her home country. It is recommended to start the process early to ensure that you will get on time for the beginning of the semester.
