




## **APPLICATION STEPS**

NOMINATION	Students cannot apply by themselves; they must be nominated by their International Office by filling in this form.  Semester 1: from March 10 <sup>th</sup> to April 11 <sup>th</sup> , 2025 Semester 2: from September 1st to 30 <sup>th</sup> , 2025
ONLINE APPLICATION	Once nominated, students will receive confirmation from our International Office, together with an incoming student guide and a link to do their online application on our MoveOn platform.  Semester 1: from May 5th to May 31 <sup>st</sup> , 2025 Semester 2: from October 13th to October 31st, 2025  Students are not required to select their classes at this point yet.
ACCEPTATION	After the application period is over, students will receive information about the process for course selection.  WARNING: classes may experience timetable modifications in the first week of class. If available, we will offer alternative spots to avoid potential overlaps.
ADDITIONAL INFORMATION FOR ERASMUS STUDENTS	The acceptance letter will be automatically issued once the nomination of the student has been accepted.  The Certificate of Arrival will be automatically issued once the arrival of the student has been confirmed.

### **COURSES SELECTION**

ECTS	There is a maximum number of ECTS credits that can be selected depending on the duration of stay at UE Valencia:
	1 Semester: 30 ECTS 2 Semesters: 60 ECTS
	One subject usually represents 6 ECTS, meaning students can choose 5 subjects per semester. We will ask student to also choose two additional classes in case there is no place left in their first choice.





Language classes	UEV offers online English and Spanish classes (level A1, A2, B1 and B2). Registration for those classes are made during the first weeks of the stay via the webpage of the university.  Face2face A1 Spanish classes (4h/week) are offered each semester and award 6 ECTS.
