European Credit transfer system

San Jorge University uses a local grading scale with marks between 0 and 10.

The main language of teaching is Spanish, therefore we strongly advice students to sign up for the intensive Spanish language course for exchange students upon their arrival.

The recommended language level is B1 both for English and/or Spanish.

Nursing and Physiotherapy students taking clinical practice: mandatory B2 level of Spanish.

Translation students: mandatory B2 level of Spanish and/or English.

Free courses are taught throughout the semester by the Institute of Modern Languages, which evaluates the student's level of Spanish to adapt the classes depending on the knowledge of each student:
