The main language of instruction is Spanish; therefore, we strongly advise students to enroll in the intensive Spanish course for exchange students upon their arrival.

The recommended language level is B1 in English and/or Spanish.

All students enrolled in any Health Sciences degree who will participate in clinical practice: mandatory B2 level in Spanish.

Students of the Bachelor's in Translation and Applied Language Technologies: mandatory B2 level in Spanish and/or English.

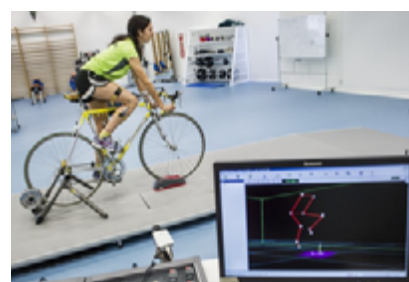
