| Application procedure | The nomination will be confirmed via email to the student and the sending institution. The email will provide a letter of acceptance and a list of documents to send to us. The final procedure will take place upon arrival. |

Exchange students may choose courses from all disciplines. In case of timetable clashes, students may change their courses on site at the beginning of the semester. Most classes are taught in French, however there are certain courses taught in other languages. Course titles are indicative of the language it is taught in.

French Language Courses

French as a second language courses are available to exchange students; each course is credited with 3 ECTS. Classes cover written and oral skills, and vary between the levels A2/beginners through C1/advanced.

Orientation week for International Students

Orientation takes place during the first few weeks of each semester, and includes academic meetings & social activities. It is also during this week that students will be formally enrolled at the University of Limoges.
