Course Information/Syllabus Course load per semester Languages of Instruction	<p>MMIC (Marketing & Management in an international context) is a curriculum which allows students to gain increased knowledge in business- and management relevant topics like entrepreneurship and negotiation, the environment of businesses (European Union, globalisation, regionalisation), management of divers aspects of importance for success (HRM, financial aspects, purchase, sales, logistics), marketing (international marketing, quantitative tools for marketing) , legal aspects (taxes, individual mobility, rules concerning trade of goods & services), economics and strategies.</p> <p>Students can obtain a degree or collect credits under the ECTS-scheme, which then are to be validated by their home university.</p> <p>The MMIC curriculum is taught by local and foreign Faculty members and by experts with professional background.</p> <p>MMIC is based on classes and intensive individual learning.</p> <p>30 ECTS per semester</p> <p>English (MMIC) or/and French (local degree programmes)</p>
