NOMINATION AND APPLICATION PROCEDURE

- 1) Students must be nominated by their home university via the nomination form (sent previously by ILERI in the email "call for nominations").
The home university must send the nomination form by email to: incoming@reseau-cd.fr
- 2) We will send a confirmation email to the home university with the application procedure:
 - a) Students must complete the online form
 - b) The home university must send by email the required documents to: incoming@reseau-cd.fr
 - A copy of the student's passport or ID card if European (page with picture and name)
 - Student's official ID picture (.jpg) (white background, facing the camera)
 - Most recent transcripts of records (with an English or a French translation)
 - Proof of B2 level in English or French

LANGUAGE REQUIREMENT

Programs taught in English : B2 (TOEIC, TOEFL, IELTS). If the student does not have one of the above certificates, we can accept an official written letter from the home university attesting that the student's level in English is sufficient to study academic courses.

Programs taught in French : B2 official certificate (TCF, ETEF, DELF)

HEALTH & INSURANCE

Students are required to provide a copy of their International Health Insurance Certificate (covering repatriation, civil liability and extra medical costs) as well as:

EU-residents: a valid copy of your European Health Insurance Card (EHIC)

Non-EU residents: a certificate proving that you applied for the French Health Scheme (Sécurité Sociale). It is mandatory and free. Register online (English website) at <https://etudiant-etranger.ameli.fr/#/> (you'll need your birth certificate to register). VISA

Check if a student visa is requested using this official visa website (available in French or in English) at <https://francevisas.gouv.fr/>. The VLS-TS student visa allows to pursue studies in France for a period of four months to one year. More information in the Student Handbook p3.
