Student Application Form:

The International Relations Office of the home university nominates students by email to Maria-Angéline BEAUCOURT.

We would like to inform you that our IT department and the International Relations Department are currently working on the implementation of the European Student Card Initiative (ESCI) functionalities within CPE Lyon. The application platform will be activated later on and you will be informed on how to apply as soon as possible.

In the meantime, all nominated students have to submit the following documents (PDF files) by email:

- Student Application Form including the Learning Agreement (page 3)
- Passport-sized picture
- ID or Passport copy
- Copy of the official transcript of records
- Curriculum Vitae
- Covering letter (in French)
- European Health Insurance Card / Private health insurance
- Liability insurance

- Proof of language proficiency (minimum B1 required). The proof can be an official test but also a certification from the Head of language department

Semester dates:

Fall semester: September to end of January
Spring Semester: February to end of June

Exam Periods:

Exchange students are requested to stay until the end of the scheduled exams. No special early exams can be arranged for them.

Attending to class is compulsory at CPE Lyon, including the French class.

CPE Lyon has its own accommodation for international students.

How to obtain a VLS-TS Student (VLS-TS "Étudiant") Visa?

Your **visa application will be automatically sent to the French consular authorities** of your home country through the platform.
