Semester dates	<p>Autumn semester: September - February</p> <p>Spring semester: February– June</p> <p>Academic calendar updated around May</p>
Organizational meeting	<p>The Integration week before courses started with intensive french courses</p> <p>During the meeting students receive all the information regarding the life around the university, timetables etc.</p>
Language of studies	French
Language level requirements	<p>ENSAM requires the official French certificates.(DELF or TCF). Attestations from teachers of universities are not accepted. The expected level, permitting students to follow classes in French is B1 . A student who has level B2 in english could be accepted.</p>
French language course	<p>Students have to take part in the Intensive French course, which starts 1 week before the beginning of the autumn semester (the course is organized only once a year). All the students must participate in the regular French course during the semesters</p>

<p>English or Spanish language course</p>	<p>Students can also take part in different English or Spanish courses (on B1, B2 and C1 levels) during the semesters.</p>
<p>Accommodation</p>	<p>ENSAM provides students with places in our dormitories located around the campus. Students choose whether they are interested in the accommodation after receiving letter of acceptance, in June or December.</p> <p>The price of a double room is around 250 EUR/month</p>
<p>Erasmus Student Tutor</p>	<p>ENSAM is strongly supported by the local associations.</p> <p>We organize also a mentor system.</p>
