Organizational meeting	The Integration week before courses started with intensive french courses During the meeting students receive all the information regarding the life around the university, timetables etc.
Language of studies	French
Language level requirements	ENSAM requires the official French certificates.(DELF or TCF). Attestations from teachers of universities are not accepted. The expected level, permitting students to follow classes in French is B1. A student who has level B2 in english could be accepted.
French language course	Students have to take part in the Intensive French course, which starts 1 week before the beginning of the autumn semester (the course is organized only once a year). All the students must participate in the regular French course during the semesters

English or Spanish language course	Students can also take part in different English or Spanish courses (on B1, B2 and C1 levels) during the semesters.
Accommodation	ENSAM provides students with places in our dormitories located around the campus. Students choose whether they are interested in the accommodation after receiving letter of acceptance, in June or December. The price of a double room is around 250 EUR/month
Erasmus Student Tutor	ENSAM is strongly supported by the local associations. We organize also a mentor system.
