



Exchange students can work on a Personal Project (PP) and can be supervised in French or in English. The subject of the Project must be defined in advance on a Learning Agreement by the student and his academic coordinators:

- POLUP05- 5 ECTS
- POLUP10- 10 ECTS
- POLUP15-15 ECTS
- POLUP20- 20 ECTS
- POLUP30- 30 ECTS



Continuous examination all through the semester.

Students must pick up courses from the same department, same option and same level to prevent courses from overlapping.

International students can register to the French courses (65€ per semester) taught at the French Institute on our Campus and be awarded with ECTS. These courses need to be added on the learning agreement of the students.

The mundus programme is dedicated to international students who hold a bachelor degree. Students are required to have a B1 level in French. They spend their 1st year at Polytech Orleans attending French intensive courses and courses from a selected engineering department.

TUITION FEES

Exchange students do not pay any tuition fees for the courses attended at Polytech Orleans. A fee of 65€ / semester will have to be paid to the French Institute if French courses are added to the learning agreement.

The Mundus programme and the AESM MSc have tuition fees.

ACCOMMODATION

Students must make a compulsory online preregistration on the University of Orleans website only after Polytech Orleans has sent their acceptance letter. The link will be given in the admission letter of the student. Accommodation is not guaranteed, housing allocation on the basis of "first arrived, first served".

Housing proposal will only be made upon reception of all the requested documents listed on the university website.
