Recommended level of the language of instruction	We ask exchange students to have the minimum recommended level - B2 to follow and participate in the courses [No certificate required for admission].
Portfolio	It is not necessary.
ECTS Credit system	One semester = 30 credits / Full academic year = 60 credits The number of credits per course varies from 2 to 10 depending on the subjects chosen by the student.

Recommended arrival date	One or two weeks before the beginning of the semester.
Orientation date	Two weeks before the beginning of each semester, we organize a reception and a training course of French language and culture, for students who wish to take it. The students have also a meeting with the international departmental coordinators.
