<b>CVEC Student and Campus Life Contribution</b>	<p>CVEC is a national fee paid by students every academic year. This contribution is "designed to promote social, health, cultural and sports support and assistance for students and to reinforce health prevention and education actions aimed at students" (<i>Article L. 841-5 of the French Education Code</i>).</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>➤ Academic Exchange Students from partner universities are exempted from CVEC.</li><li>➤ All degree-seeking Students (Double Degree included) have to pay for CVEC <a href="#">here</a>.</li></ul>
