<b>French Language Courses</b>	ECLA (ENS-PSL Languages Center) offers an intensive French course to international students during the first two weeks of September. The course is free of charge, for all levels (A1 to C2) and includes cultural outings. A similar course in a shorter format (3 days) is offered in mid-January for students studying abroad during the Spring Semester. Exchange students may also attend French courses throughout the semester/year and validate ECTS credits.	
<b>Departmental Coordinators</b>	The CDRIs ( <i>Correspondants de la Direction des Relations Internationales</i> ) are the primary points of contact for exchange students when it comes to academic matters (choosing courses, signing the Learning Agreements, etc). ## FURTHER INFORMATION

<b>Visa</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Students who are citizens of EU or EEA countries do not need a visa to study in France.</li> <li>Students who are not citizens of EU or EEA countries need a long-stay visa to study in France (&gt; 90 days).</li> <li>After receiving the acceptance letter from the ENS-PSL International Office (in April/May or in November), students must submit their visa application through the official website <a href="#">France-Visas</a>. The procedure includes a visit to a France Visa center in the home or resident country, so we advise students to start this process as soon as possible.</li> </ul>
<b>Accommodation</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>If accommodation is <b>not</b> included in the exchange agreement, the ENS-PSL International Office provides a list of useful links for students looking for accommodation in Paris.</li> </ul>
<b>Health Insurance</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Citizens of EU member states, Iceland, Liechtenstein, Norway or Switzerland have access to the European Health Insurance Card (EHIC). They don't need to register for French Student Social Security. This card must be requested in your country of origin and be valid until at least the end of the academic year. The European Health Insurance Card gives access to care in France.</li> <li>Exchange students who are not eligible for the European Health Card (EHIC) and who are not covered by national health plans must have private health insurance.</li> </ul>
<b>Students with Disabilities</b>	ENS-PSL welcomes students with disabilities and offers the necessary facilities and support. Students and their home institution should highlight any disability at the application stage so that their needs and requirements can be addressed and the right support assured prior to their acceptance.
