<b>LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS</b>	Minimum B1 level in French and English expected (according to the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages CERF)
<b>NOMINATION/ APPLICATION DEADLINES</b>	<b>Fall semester</b> : nomination before March 27; application from March 1 to April 10 <b>Spring semester</b> : nomination before November 6; application from October 1 to November 10
<b>APPLICATION PROCEDURE</b>	Nominations to be sent by email to <a href="mailto:welcome@insa-toulouse.fr">welcome@insa-toulouse.fr</a> Applications must be submitted through our online portal. Nominated students will receive a link to log into the portal and complete their application.

<b>WELCOME SESSION</b>	Our Welcome Session is organized at the beginning of each academic semester (September and January). Attendance is mandatory. <b>HEALTH INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS AND COSTS</b>	Students must apply for health insurance ( <i>Sécurité sociale</i> ) in France. It is mandatory and free, and it must be done when arriving in France.
