German language courses	We offer 4 week long preparatory intensive German language courses (levels A1, A2, B1, B2) before the start of each semester. Courses cost €100 and will earn 3 ECTS credits upon successful completion.

Visa	For non-EU citizens: Obtaining a visa for Germany takes at least 6 weeks. We recommend applying for a visa as early as 6-8 weeks before departure to avoid late arrival.
