

Language of instruction and language requirements

Generally, the language of instruction is Croatian but a number of courses are held in English and other foreign languages.

The incoming students can attend the course Croatian language and Culture at the Department of Croatian Studies (4 ECTS).

The language requirements for the incoming students (in reading, listening, writing, and speaking): level B2 on the CEFR scale (Common European Framework of Reference for Languages) or equivalent.

The Ministry of Science, Education and Youth provides all Erasmus+ and CEEPUS students with the student card (X-card). The card is issued by the Office for undergraduate and graduate students of the University of Zadar and it costs 11,70 €. It enables students to get meals at the discount price at the student restaurant. Other categories of the incoming students are not entitled to get the student card (X-card).

ESTIMATED EXPENSES AT UNIZD

Housing in UNIZD dormitory

The University of Zadar has two dormitories, and the price depends on the accommodation category.

Accommodation in a double/triple room (address: Franje Tuđmana 24d)

60 € / month

Accommodation for disabled persons (address: Put Stanova 1a)

80 € / month

Accommodation in a double room (address: Put Stanova 1a)

110 € / month

Numerical grading system is compared to the ECTS system as follows:

Excellent (5)	5 – A	A – 5
Very good (4)	4 – B	B – 4
Good (3)	3 – C	C – 3
Sufficient (2)	2 – D	D, E – 2
Fail (1)	1 – F	FX, F – 1
