GRADING SYSTEM	The Hungarian system of assessment consists of a five-point grading scale. These are as follows: • Excellent (5) • Good (4) • Satisfactory (3) • Pass (2) • Fail (1) One academic year consists of two terms (autumn & spring semesters) which can be further divided into 3 further periods such as registration, term-time (lecture period), and exam period. • Registration: the student can finalize his/her schedule, enroll for the upcoming term, and take part in orientation days. • Duration of the registration: 1 week • Duration of the term-time: 14 weeks • Duration of the exam-time: 6 weeks (at least 28 working days)
