

Language requirements	The Erasmus students are not required to submit a specific language certificate, but they are highly recommended to have at least a B1 level certificate in the Italian language due to the fact that most of the courses and the exams are held in Italian. A course of Italian language is available for free for all Erasmus students, at the CLI (Linguistic Center). CLI: http://www.cli.unipi.it/corsi/corsi/italiano-l2-erasmus On their arrival in Pisa, students should register at the C.L.I. webpage in order to sign themselves for the admission test. After the test they will be admitted to the appropriate course depending on their language proficiency.

	2. Using the ALICE username and password, access the Erasmus Manager Portal and fill the application form and upload your ID card and photo: https://unipi.erasmusmanager.it/incoming/AF login.aspx
	3. You will receive a confirmation from robot@llpmanager.it ; after the confirmation, please upload your Learning Agreement "Before the Mobility" on Erasmus Manager Portal signed by your Erasmus coordinator.

	4. When your Learning Agreement will be signed by our Erasmus Coordinator, you will receive a confirmation from robot@llpmanager.it . Then you could contact the International Relations office of the University of Pisa at in order to make an appointment and pick up your multiservice card and complete your enrolment at the University of Pisa: https://unipi.erasmusmanager.it/incoming/appuntamento_00.aspx
