| Language course | All courses are taught in Italian apart from the Master Degree in Food Engineering that is taught in English (www.adic.unisa.it/foodlm) and some courses held at the Faculty of Languages (www.lingue.unisa.it/en/index). |
| Level required | For course taught in Italian no language requirement are asked (except Faculty of Languages). |
| Italian language certification | No requirement |
| Italian language course | <p>Before the beginning of each term, the University of Salerno organizes intensive Italian language courses free of charge for all incoming students. The aim is to give students a basic competence in Italian in order to guarantee them a better understanding of courses. After attending the course, students will receive a certificate with a final mark and 12 credits, if they pass the test.</p> <p>More info: www.international.unisa.it/cli/index</p> |

| Accommodation | <p>Incoming students looking for accommodation in private rented rooms in the town of Salerno should contact the student association <i>AEGEE Salerno</i>, with whom the University of Salerno has an agreement.</p> <p>Email: info@aegeesalerno.org; Website: www.aegeesalerno.org</p> <p>Incoming students can also apply for the halls of residence on Campus if the students' stay lasts a whole academic year (ten months).</p> <p>Costs are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - € 210 per person in a three bedroom flat - € 260 per person in a one bedroom flat (fees included). <p>Beware: Accommodation on Campus is not guaranteed.</p> <p>More info: www.adisu.sa.it</p> |
| RESIDENCE PERMIT | |
| EU / EEA citizens | No requirements |
| Non-EU citizens | <p>As soon as the application procedure is concluded, non UE students will receive the invitation letter by the University of Salerno</p> <p>The invitation letter will enable non UE students to contact the Italian Embassy or Consulate to obtain the VISA.</p> <p>Before leaving for Italy non EU students must have:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - a valid passport; - the Visa issued by the Embassy or Consulate; - the insurance covering them from health problems and accidents for the whole period of their stay. <p>All the above-mentioned documents will enable students to set up the procedure to apply for a residence permit (Permesso di soggiorno), which is compulsory. Students will be charged about € 80 for this residence permit.</p> |
| HEALTH INSURANCE | |
| EU / EEA citizens | Valid <i>European Health Insurance Card</i> . |
| Non-EU citizens | Evidence of private medical insurance. |
| TRANSCRIPTS | |
