Study areas <i>Campus Lisboa</i>	Architecture, Arts and Multimedia Communication, Business management, Design, Economy, Human resources management, Informatics engineering, Jazz and modern music, Law, Marketing, Psychology, International Relations, Security and Justice, Social work, Sports organization's management.

Grading scale	Lusíada adopts a system compatible with ECTS. The Portuguese grading system ranges from 0 to 20, with 10 as passing grade. To pass, the final degree classification shall express a value ranging from 10 to 20 with ECTS grades (A, B, C, D, E). If the student fails, the final degree classification shall express a value ranging from 9 to 0 with ECTS grades (FX, F).
Transcript of the records	The transcript of the records is issued within five weeks after the end of each semester and is sent by the ECTS Institutional Coordinator directly to the student University Coordinator.



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LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS	
Language proficiency	UNIVERSIDADE LUSÍADA does not require any official certification on language skills.
Teaching Language	Portuguese is the official teaching language. Lectures and assessments are in <u>Portuguese</u> , so we highly recommend a level equivalent to a B1 (according to the European Common Framework Reference of Languages) before coming to our University. Lessons and exams in other languages will depend only on the lecturer who gives the course.
Portuguese Intensive Language Course	Universidade Lusíada offers a four-week Portuguese intensive language and culture course for those willing to improve their language skills. The Course takes place on our <i>campus</i> in Lisbon (face to face) and online in Porto and Famalicão <i>campuses</i> . Its participation is free; however, it requires previous enrolment. NOTE: availability for the second semester to be confirmed.
