PRACTICAL INFORMATION

Accommodation

A limited number of places available at dormitories for exchange students. The majority of places are in **double rooms** with a shared bathroom and kitchen.

Students apply for accommodation in the on-line application form at the IRK platform (one form for both studies and accommodation).

The places are assigned on a "*first come first served*" basis, therefore it is important to apply as early as possible. Students who do not receive a place in a dormitory are offered guidance in finding a room or apartment to rent.
