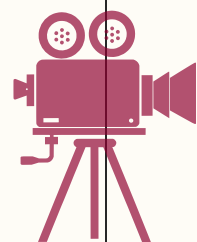

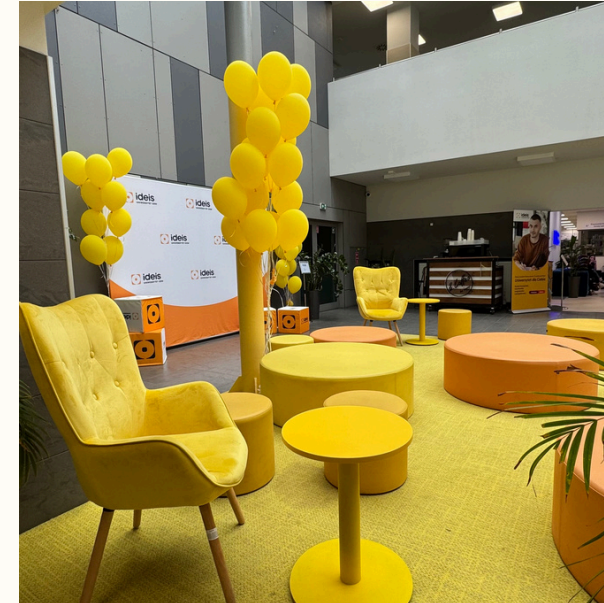
Buddy Program

- various discounts for entries to ZOO, cinemas, cultural institutions, in cafeterias or restaurants

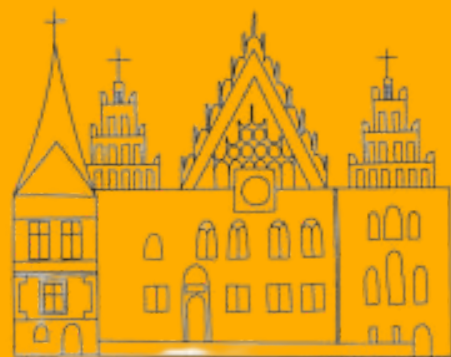
