Course selection	Students can choose ONLY courses available on the online platform. Students can choose courses from different study programs (both BSc and MSc).
Application deadlines	Autumn semester: 30 th June Spring semester: 30 th November
Semester dates	Autumn semester: October - February Spring semester: March – July Academic calendar (updated around May – June)
Organizational meeting	Organized usually on Friday preceding the beginning of each semester. During the meeting students receive all the practical information regarding the life around the university, timetables etc. The detailed information about the date of the meeting will be sent in the Letter of Acceptance.
Language of instruction	English
Language level requirements	TUL does not require the official English certificates. However, the expected level, permitting students to follow classes in English, is B1+/B2.
Polish language course	Students are welcome to take part in the Intensive Survival Polish course, which starts around 2 weeks before the beginning of the autumn semester (the course is organized only once a year). All the students can participate in the regular Polish A1 course during the semester.
English language course	Students can also take part in different English courses (on B1+, B2 and C1/C2 levels) during the semester.
Accommodation	TUL provides students with places in our dormitories located around the campus. Students choose whether they are interested in the accommodation during their online application. The price of a double room is around 100 EUR/month.
Erasmus Student Network	TUL is strongly supported by the local ESN section, ESN-EYE , which is responsible e.g. for mentor system .

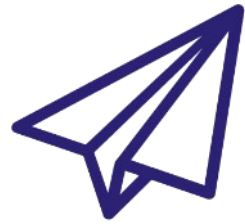
