For a better communication with the administrators of the hostels, all the information will be sent to the administrators by the Erasmus+ Office.</p> <p>Details for arrival at the hostels will be sent to the incoming students 1 month before each semester will begin.</p>

In case the home institution requires original copies, these will be sent by regular mail.
Insurance	Incoming students are advised to have the European Health Insurance Card (EHIC) for studies abroad or a private travel and health insurance valid for Shengen area , for the duration of their Erasmus studies / placement at Cluj-Napoca
