GRADING SYSTEM

Grading system and grade distribution table: Student performance is graded on a scale of 10 (Excellent) to 5-1 (Fail). A passing grade for an exam is achieved with a score ranging from 6 to 10.

10 (Excellent)	A (Excellent)	Exceptional knowledge with negligible errors.
9 (Very Good)	B (Very Good)	Above average knowledge, but with some errors.

7 (Good)	D (Satisfactory)	Good knowledge, but with major errors.
6 (Poor)	E (Sufficient)	Knowledge which meets the minimum criteria.
5 – 1 (Unsatisfactory)	F, FX (Fail)	Knowledge which does not meet the minimum criteria.

4. ACCOMMODATION

Accommodation in the University of Primorska dormitories is not possible and relevant for mobile students.

Sharing a flat is a popular choice among students, as it offers more affordable living costs and the opportunity to meet people from diverse backgrounds. In most cases, incoming mobile students can expect to arrange accommodation in private housing.

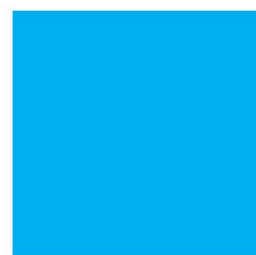

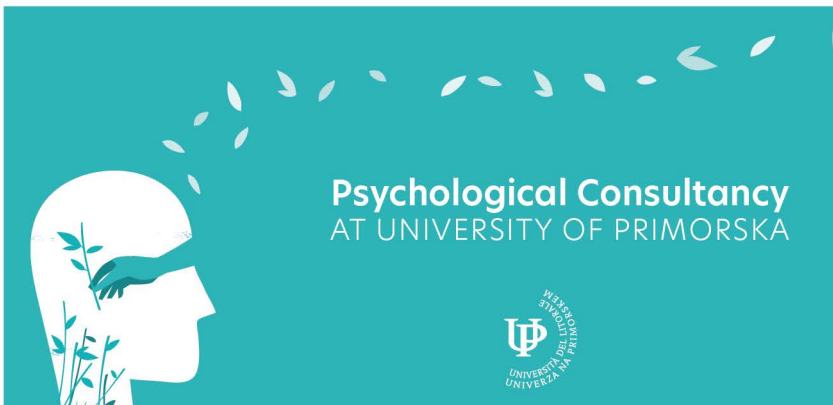

Psychological support

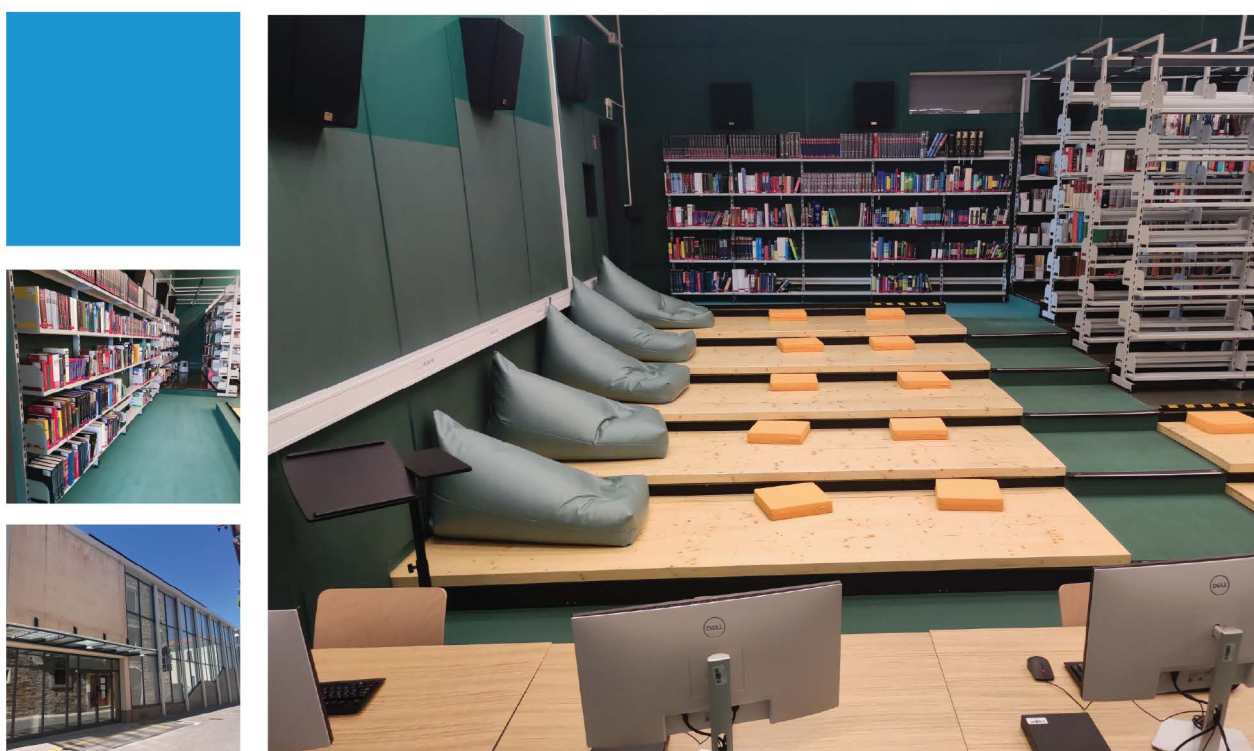




ESN – Erasmus Student Network
