2.4. Housing

2.5. Visa

<u>EEA Citizens:</u> For students from the European Economic Area (EU and EFTA countries) and Switzerland there are no specific requirements to enter Slovakia. A valid passport or national ID card is sufficient to enter Slovakia.

Other Nationals: For students from no-European Union or European Free Trade Association countries, an entry or residence permit for entry into and residence in Slovakia is required. The type of permit depends on the length of your stay. Please see for detailed information:

Accommodation

Trnava University provides accommodation for exchange students in the dormitory - "Petra Pázmaňa" dormitory on Rybníkova street 13/A in Trnava. The dormitory is located only 5 minutes walk from the main University building. Students are accommodated in double-bed rooms with shower, toilet, washbasin and the wardrobe. Since the number of places is limited, Erasmus+ students who submit their application forms to the IRO office early (before 1st of June or the 1st of December are given priority. Warning: Students from winter term may stay in the dormitory till 25.01., because the summer term starts in February.

Equipment and services

Each room is equipped with a bed, desks, table lamps, bookshelves, chairs, large wardrobe, wifi. Bedding and bed linen are provided (bed linen is regularly changed). You will need own towels, kitchenware, cutlery. There is also a shared kitchen on every floor equipped with a gas cooker and a sink. The rooms are equipped with the small refrigerator. The dormitory provides also self-service launderette.

Price

The monthly rent for each student is 85 EUR per month. The rent must be paid by the 10th of each month. All students from EU countries must pay their rent electronically. Only students from non-EU countries are allowed to pay in cash at the office of Mrs. Baranova in the dormitory. Upon arrival are students asked to pay a deposit for their room in the amount of 100 EUR. The deposit will be given to you back before your departure in the case, if your room is presented in a very good condition.
