1. NOMINATION

Students should be nominated by their home institutions before they start their applications. Applications submitted without nominations are considered as invalid.

Erasmus office informs the students and the sending institution about the application procedure by e-mail soon after the nomination.	

2. HOW TO APPLY

After the nomination is sent, students will receive an e-mail and a guide from the YTU Erasmus office, explaining the steps to be followed.

Online Application Module: www.ytuerasmus.yildiz.edu.tr. Students must submit their online application through the application module. The application module is active only in the application period.

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3. ONLINE APPLICATION PERIOD

Fall semester/full year : 15 May – 15 July

Spring semester : 15 October – 15 December

Nominations and applications received after the deadlines are considered as invalid.

4. APPLICATION DOCUMENTS

Students need to upload the documents listed below to the application module within the deadlines. Details are mentioned in the application guide which is sent after nomination.

- 1. Copy of the passport ID page
- 2. Official transcript of records
- 3. Passport size photo for the student ID

5. PROCESSING APPLICATIONS

Processing the applications requires 4-6 weeks. Students are expected to check their e-mails and the application module regularly as we may need to request more information/documentation from the applicants.

6. FINAL DECISION

After students complete their online applications, Erasmus office sends their applications to the departmental coordinator for approval. Once the Learning Agreement (LA) is signed by the departmental coordinator, students can download LA and Letter of Acceptance (duly signed and stamped) from the application module.

Erasmus students are assessed in the same way as all other students on the same course. That is, they must sit examinations and complete the tasks set by the academic department offering the course.
Attendance	Regular and punctual class attendance is compulsory. Students may receive a failing grade due to absence.
