Portfolio (if applicable)	Nominated students are expected to prepare a portfolio of 12 -15 digital images to support their application. Once the student has submitted their online application to us, they will be sent specific instructions on how and where to upload their portfolio images. The quality of the portfolio can be the deciding factor in whether a student is accepted or not.
