Incoming Mobility: Application process and Academic Information

In order to apply to De Montfort University for Erasmus+ study, an active exchange agreement with your home institution must be in place prior to your application. You must be nominated by your Erasmus Coordinator/ Tutor. You cannot apply individually or directly to our university. Once we will receive your nomination, you will be sent an information package and instructions on how to apply.

After Application Deadline all the applications will be sent to the faculty. Shortlisting process might take up to 6 weeks. Once we will have the results, each student will be emailed an Acceptance Letter. Please, read it very carefully and respond to it. When we receive your acceptance of the offer, you will be assigned with Unconditional Firm offer, which will allow you to book on campus accommodation.

One Semester Students	Plan your study period carefully to ensure you will meet the 90-day minimum duration for your home university. Semester 1 at De Montfort University is short and your attendance during Welcome Week is mandatory.

Language requirements	All modules are delivered in English. Applicants should be at 6.0 IELTS standard Arts, Design and Technology subjects and 6.5 for Business and Law, Social Sciences and Humanities subjects. We require a proof of any qualification demonstrating a minimum of level B2 according to the Common European Framework. In the absence of the above requirements, participants will be asked to send us their supervisor statement indicating participant English language proficiency according to the Common European Framework. Please note students requiring a visa for a full year study at DMU will need to show formal language qualifications.
English language support	We offer free English language support while you are studying – two hours per week for undergraduate and research students, and three hours per week for postgraduate students.
