Boğaziçi University was officially established in 1971 as a Turkish public university, but its history goes back to Robert College (1863), the first American college set up outside the United States.

The University includes four faculties, six graduate institutes, a School of Applied disciplines, and a School of Foreign Languages.

Boğaziçi University Summer Term is an intensive seven-week program offering a rich variety of courses in the social and natural sciences, humanities, engineering and technology. The medium of instruction is English (unless otherwise specified). The Summer Term begins in mid-June and ends by the second week of August.

WHY BOĞAZİÇİ UNIVERSITY SUMMER TERM?

All applicants must fulfill the English proficiency requirements of Boğaziçi University except for students coming from universities where the official language of instruction is English.
