ABOUT BOTH COURSES

All attending students follow a general module and choose one elective: Sustainable Entrepreneurial Thinking or Peace, Justice, Human Right and European Union Cooperation.

The full program is worth 4 ECTS: 1 ECTS for the general module and 3 ECTS for the elective of choice.

SUSTAINABLE ENTREPRENEURIAL THINKING - *Entrepreneurship meets global challenges*

TARGET GROUP

Any student with an entrepreneurial spirit who is eager to learn how to set up a sustainable business.

COURSE AIM

Are you curious about how your skills can help create a positive impact on global challenges? This module invites participants to explore the intersection of entrepreneurial thinking and sustainability. Whether you are a critical thinker, a creative mind, or a planner, this module challenges you to align your passions and skills with the SDGs. Students will explore what it means to be an entrepreneur in today's world and how entrepreneurial initiatives can address pressing societal challenges.
