THE INTERN

The programme is aimed at undergraduates currently completing their second year at university in courses such as political science, communications or business where there is a strong European focus

An ideal candidate should have:

- An interest in the politics, policy and people of the European Union and how it impacts the business environment
- Excellent computer and internet research skills: Word, PowerPoint, Excel, knowledge of European Union institutional websites
- Strong analytical skills and digital expertise
- The capacity to deal with conflicting priorities, work under pressure and deliver on deadlines
- Excellent communication skills and networking ability
- An ability to work in an innovative environment, with a proactive and multi-cultural team
- Fluency in English (oral and written) with an ability to use at least one other European language

THE APPLICATION

Interested students should submit a Curriculum Vitae and a letter of motivation to FleishmanHillard via the course leader at their university:

- Initial applications should be submitted via their course leaders by Friday, 28th January 2022, 5pm BST
- Interviews with selected students (selection based on prior written test) will take place in mid-February 2022
- Non-European nationals need to have the right to work in Belgium
